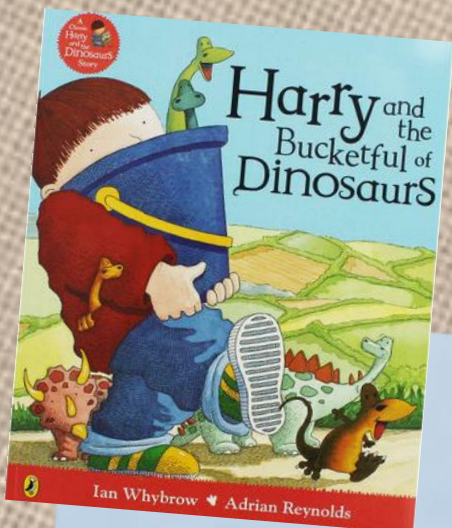

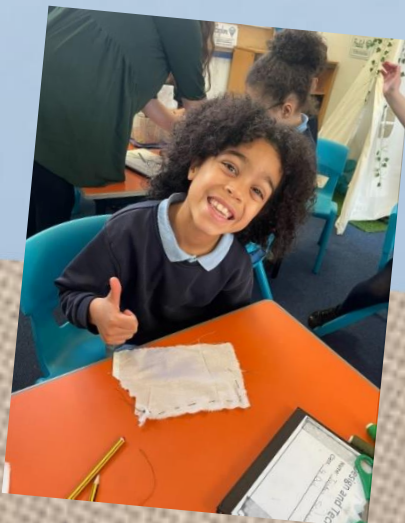


Our first alumni!

This week's learning.

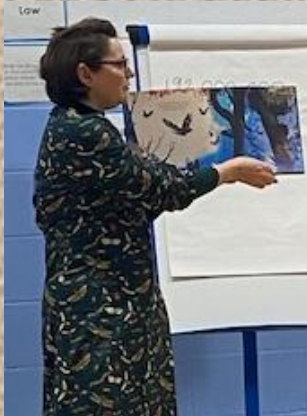
- Nursery have been having a 'roarsome' time learning all about dinosaurs and reading the story 'Harry and his Bucketful of Dinosaurs'.
