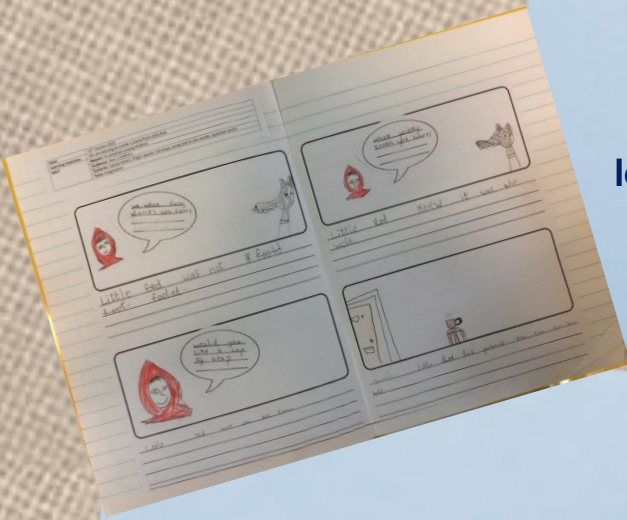




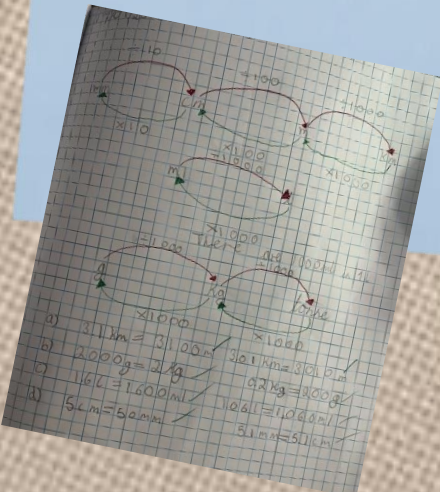
Exciting news!
