**Parent surveys.**

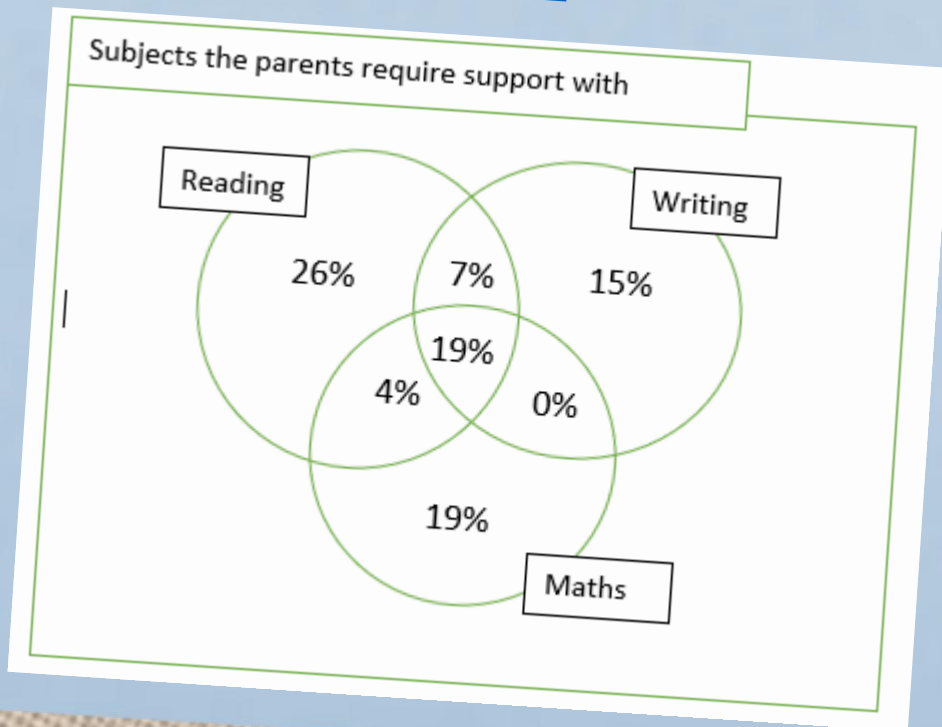


As you can see from the Venn diagram below, most of the parents that completed our survey requested support with their child's reading.
