Year 3 - Autumn 2

Reading

In Autumn we will be reading lots of fairytales we already know but thinking about them from different viewpoints. There will also be some more traditional tales written by the Brothers Grimm

Writing

We will be investigating dinosaurs. Our first writing text will be an information poster that will be written in an entertaining way. We will continue to develop our dialogue skills later in the term.

Maths

We will be continuing our topic on Addition and Subtraction. After this we will focus on multiplication and division. Children will also continue learning their 2 times tables.

Science

Year 3 classes will be learning about light in our physics lessons. They will investigate the relationship between light and how we see. Including the formation of shadows.

<u>Art</u>

Children will be thinking about why people make art. They will consider the cave paintings in Lascaux and make a painting.

Computing

Children will be using online applications to create sequences of music.

History

In history, we will be learning about Prehistoric Britain and how settlements changed across different ages.

Spanish

In Spanish, we are learning how to discuss ourselves and others in a variety of ways.

Music

In music, we will be exploring how to improvise. We will be sharing our ideas while experimenting with glockenspiels.

In PE, we will be practising our gymnastics skills, collaborating with others to create sequences.

In PSHE, we will be learning how to look after our mental and emotional health, as well as managing our feelings.

In RE, we will be exploring what the Trinity is in Christianity. We will look at how the Trinity has been symbolised through the years.
