


The key climate zones in Brazil are equatorial, tropical, highland tropical, subtropical and semi-arid.	<b>Urban</b>	Urban areas are areas where many people live and work.
The key physical features in Brazil are the Amazon, Iguazu Falls, Amazon river and river basin, highlands, pampas and Copacabana beach.	<b>Rural</b>	Rural areas are farming or agricultural areas.
Land use in Brazil is mainly agriculture. Although Brazil is changing as urban settlements grow and the rainforest is being chopped down.	<b>Settlements</b>	A settlement is a community where people live.

**Did you know?**

The capital of Brazil is Brasilia, but the largest city is Sao Paulo. Brasilia was designed by Oscar Niemeyer and Lucio Coster in the 1950s. It was made a UNESCO World Heritage site in 1987.
