Impact

The Year 2 curriculum is of a high quality and shows progression across the year to support children to achieve their own targets and those set by the school. Maths is taught systematically following Maths No Problem which enables children to become fluent, reason and solve problems. Phonics is taught systematically using Read, Write, Inc. Through the teaching of systematic phonics, our aim is for children to become fluent readers and develop a love of reading by the end of Key Stage One. This way, children can focus on understanding and interpreting more challenging texts as they move through the school.
