Dear Parents,

During this half term, Year 1's topic will be 'Here I am 53 degrees North'. Attached to this letter is your child's Knowledge Organiser which contain key facts, vocabulary and information about your child's learning in class.

Our learning:

- In Reading, our class texts will be a range of fiction and nonfiction texts linked to the seasons and capital cities.
- In Writing, we will be writing character descriptions of the Queen, recounts of a field trip around our school and season descriptions.
- In Maths, the children will be learning about numbers to 10, number bonds and addition within 10.
- In Science, the children will be looking at the four seasons of the year and will be comparing them against one another.
- In Geography, the children will be exploring where they live. They will be focusing on the United Kingdom and will do fieldwork around Abbey Hey primary School grounds.
- In R.E. we will be focusing on Christianity looking at the question 'What makes a Christian and what do they believe?'
- In P.E, the children will be learning how to make our body curl, tense, stretch and relax.
- In Art, the children will be focusing on primary and secondary colours. They will be using these colours to create a piece of artwork.

Please support your child at home in ensuring that they are reading each day independently and to you and they also have opportunities to listen to an adult read to them.

You can use the information on their Knowledge Organisers to test your child's recall of facts and their understanding of the new vocabulary listed.

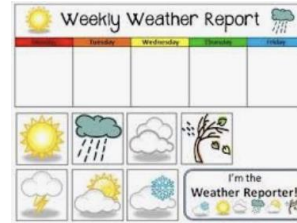


Home Learning Projects:

Make a weather chart to observe the weather throughout the year.



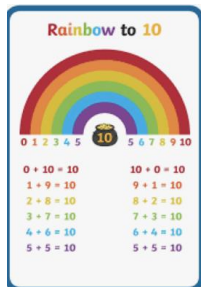
Paint, draw or collage a picture using primary and secondary colours.
