

Dear Parents,

During this half term, Year 1's topic will be 'What do animals eat?' Attached to this letter is your child's Knowledge Organiser's which contain key facts, vocabulary and information about your child's learning in class.

### Our learning:

- In Reading, our class texts will be a range of fiction and non-fiction texts linked to different types of animals and families.
- In Writing, we will be writing a recount of our dinosaur visit, a description of a carnivore, an animal poem and a job description for an animal.
- In Maths, the children will be learning about subtraction within 10, position and direction, number and place value within 20 and addition and subtraction within 20.
- In Science, the children will be learning about different types of animals including humans. We will also be learning the basic parts of a human body.
- In History, the children will be exploring different types of families and looking into our own family history.
- In R.E. we will be focusing on Christianity looking at the question 'What can we learn from sacred books?' We will also be learning the main teachings of the bible.
- In P.E, the children will be learning all about dance. We will be dancing to music by copying dance moves while also creating our own dances.
- In Design and Technology, the children will be exploring healthy foods, how humans feed themselves and how we can cut food safely.

Please support your child at home in ensuring that they are reading each day independently and to you and they also have opportunities to listen to an adult read to them. Please make a comment in your child's reading record once they have completed reading at home.

You can use the information on their Knowledge Organisers to test your child's recall of facts and their understanding of the new vocabulary listed.

If you require any additional information, please contact your child's class teacher who will be happy to assist you.
