

What does it mean to belong to a faith community?

This half term, our focus is to answer the question '**What does it mean to belong to a faith community?**'

The term 'faith community' refers to a group of people (of any size) that live near each other and follow the same religious traditions.

Key facts

- We live in a community that belongs to many different religions.
- We belong to many different groups in our lives, these could be faith based or not.
- There are certain rites of passage that each faith group should undertake during their lives.
- A Bar Mitzvah takes place when a boy is 13 years old while a Bat Mitzvah takes place when a girl is 12 years old.

Key Vocabulary

Faith:	Strong religious beliefs.
Community:	A group of people living in the same place and having things in common.
Ceremony:	A religious occasion to celebrate something important.
Baptism:	Welcoming a baby into the Christian faith by placing holy water on its head.
Naming ceremony:	An event that gives a baby their name.
Bar Mitzvah:	A ceremony where a Jewish boy becomes an adult.
Bat Mitzvah:	A ceremony where a Jewish girl becomes an adult.
Rites of passage:	A main event in someone's life.
