### **The Abbey Hey Primary Academy Uniform is as follows:**

- School sweatshirt/cardigan with school logo

- Pale blue gingham summer dress
- Plain black school shoes or plain black trainers. ***Please note that if trainers are being worn, they must be completely black with no other colours visible.***
- A coat for play time
- No 'extreme' haircuts
- Long hair must be tied back – bows must be blue or black only
- No acrylic nails or nail varnish
- Children must not wear any jewellery other than stud earrings
- No make up
