- White shirt
- School tie
- School blazer
- V neck school jumper or cardigan (Optional)
- Grey or black skirt/ Grey or black school trousers
- Plain black or blue tights
- Pale blue gingham summer dress
- Plain black school shoes or plain black trainers. Please note that if trainers are being worn, they must be completely black with no other colours visible.

Indoor PE Kit

- Black or Navy Blue shorts
- White T-Shirt
- Bare feet

Outdoor PE Kit

- Black or Navy shorts or tracksuit
- Plain White T-Shirt/Black or Navy Sweatshirt
- Outdoor Trainers

Additional Expectations

- No 'extreme' haircuts
- Long hair must be tied back for PE and any other activities where it may pose a risk such as some

- No acrylic nails or nail varnish
- Children must not wear any jewellery other than stud earrings
