

School Closure Learning Plan

As the majority of children will be educated from home from next week, we would like to share with you details of how this will work.

Every child will be given a Home Learning book which will have daily learning tasks for your child to complete. These books will contain two weeks of work which will be supplemented by additional tasks which can be found on the school website.

Please contact your child's class teacher if you are unable to access the school website or online learning.

Teachers will provide daily work for every child in a Home Learning book. Teachers will be available during the school day through ClassDojo to support parents with any learning set.

Teachers will provide additional links to online learning resources through each Year Group page on the school website.

School will provide support if you have any safeguarding or child protection concerns (see the school website).

School will communicate regularly with families through ClassDojo, school website, and the school's Facebook page.

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Teachers will ring every child once a week to discuss and support them with the learning they have been doing.

Parents will notify teachers through ClassDojo if their child is having difficulty accessing the learning that has been set. Parents will ensure that their child:

- Engages in learning every day.
- Reads for at least 15 minutes every day.
- Completes the work that has been set by the teacher.

Parents will ensure their child speaks to the teacher when they phone.

Parents will monitor their child's computer usage for online safety.
