This photograph is a **secondary source**, because it was created by someone who did not experience the time first-hand

Vocabulary

- **chronology**: things in the order that they happened
- **chronological**: describing things in the order that they happened
- **historical source**: something that gives us information about the past
- **primary source**: a historical source that was created by someone who experienced the time firsthand
- **recent**: describing things that happens not very long ago
- **secondary source**: a historical source that was created by someone who did not experience the time firsthand
- **source**: where something comes from
