

Dear Parents/Carers,

We can't believe we have already completed our first term in Year 1. The children have settled in well and we can't believe the amount of progress they have made already. Let's make this next half term an amazing term for learning. This letter will tell you the information that your child will be learning about in class. Further information about their learning can be found on our school website.

Getting Ready to Come to School

Children will need to come to school every day:

- Wearing their school uniform
- With their bookbag and water bottle
- Ready to learn!

Our Learning:

English	In English, our first unit is based around the story of 'Stanley's Stick'. Children will create their own story based the journey of a stick. Our next piece of writing will be based on the story 'Look Up! The children will arrive create their own informative text about themselves or another topic of their choice Our final piece of writing will be based around book 'Traction Man'. The children will create their own comic strip based on the adventures of Traction Man.
Maths	In Maths, the children will be learning about addition and subtraction with 20.
Science	In Science, our focus is chemistry we will be learning about everyday materials where we will be distinguishing different objects from their material and describing simple properties.
Geography	In Geography, we will be learning about 'Where we Are'. The children will be locating their local area in the UK and identifying the four countries of the UK. We will also be identifying some key human and physical features
Art	In Art, we will be learning about the artist Charles McGee. The children will explore mark making and will learn how to make a 3D paper sculpture by twisting paper and gluing it onto a base.
Religion and Worldviews	In R.E. we will be learning about Christianity and Judaism. We will be exploring the question of "Who made the world?"
PE	In P.E, the children will be focusing on dance and basketball. In dance they will be learning to perform their own dance moves, make up a short dance and move safely in a space. In basketball they will be learning how to throw and catch a ball with both hands.
Music	In Music, we will be introducing tempo and dynamics. We will be exploring the question 'How does music make the world a better place?" We will be exploring different types of music using the glockenspiels.
Computing	In Computing, we fill focus on digital art and painting. We will explore how to create different pieces of art using online software. We will create art inspired by different artists.
PSHE	In PSHE we will be looking at rules for keeping us safe at school and at home. We will explore our understanding of rules for household substances, and we will look at what we need to do in case of an emergency.

Phonics	Phonics videos will also be shared on Class Dojo weekly. Please practise phonics every day as
	we get the children ready for the phonics screening at the start of June.
