

Dear Parents/Carers,

We can't believe we have reached Summer I in Year 3! The children have had an amazing year so far and we are blown away by all of the progress that they have made. Let's make this next half term an amazing term for learning. This letter will tell you the information that your child will be learning about in class. Further information about their learning can be found on our school website.

Getting Ready to Come to School

Children will need to come to school every day:

- Wearing their school uniform
- With their bookbag and water bottle
- Ready to learn!

Our Learning:

Our Learning:	
English	In Writing, we will begin with our 'Fables' unit where the children will write their own Fable with a moral. We will then learn about our 'Creating Atmospheres' unit where we will write a narrative from a first-person viewpoint in order to affect the mood of the reader. In reading we will be looking at a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts, including a Space Fact File, stories about robots and inventions, and a poetry text. The children will answer a range of questions about these texts.
Maths	We will be continuing to measure and find conversions in our Mass and Capacity unit. We will then deepen our understanding of Fractions in our 'Fractions B' unit. Finally, we will be adding and subtracting pounds and pence, and finding change in our 'Money' unit.
Science	Our science topic is Forces and Motion. We will be finding out what forces are and what they do. We will be showing forces and looking at balanced and unbalanced forces. We will also be looking at Friction and finding out what types of surfaces have the greatest friction.
Geography	We will be Looking at Europe. We will be looking at 3 regions of Europe. We will be finding out about tourism and social, economic and environmental impacts.
Design Technology	In Design Technology, the children will be designing and making sandwiches with a balance of proteins, fats and carbohydrates.
Religion and Worldviews	We will be looking at the religion of Islam. We will be finding out about hijabs and Tawhid. We will also be visiting a mosque to gain first hand experience of how Muslims worship and to learn about the features of a mosque.
PE	Our PE Unit is Athletics. We will be setting challenges for distance and time that involve using different styles and combinations of running, jumping and skipping.



Music	Our Music unit is 'Bringing Us Together'. We will listen and respond to the song, learn to sing it, play along to it with our instruments and finally perform it.
Computing	Our Computing unit is Events and Actions. Children will be following instructions, debugging movement and designing a maze.
PSHE	In PSHE our unit is 'Living in the Wider World'. We will learn how rules and laws protect us, the difference between our local British community and global communities, and the links between work and money.
