Our Learning:

| English | In English, our first unit is based around the story of 'Little Red'. Children will explore using questions. Their final piece of writing will be creating their own storyboard using questions and speech bubbles. Our next piece of writing will be based on the story 'Beegu'. Children will arrive in school one day to find a crashed spaceship in our corridor, and they must create a 'Lost Poster' to try and find the alien Beegu. Our final piece of writing will be based around the non-fiction book 'The Big Book of the UK', where the children will create a leaflet all about Abbey Hey Primary school for parents who would like their children to come to Abbey Hey. |

| Maths | In Maths, the children will be learning addition and subtraction with 10 and beginning to look at 2D and 3D shapes. |
| Science | In Science, our focus is physics. We will be learning about seasonal changes where we will look at the four different seasons and compare the weather in these seasons. |
| History | In History, we will explore the question 'What was life, like in the past?' We will be looking at family history and how this has changed over time. |
| Design and Technology | In DT, the children will be looking at food. Children will be preparing a colourful fruit salad and crudites. |
| RE | In R.E. we will be learning about the Christmas and exploring the question 'Why does Christmas matter to Christians?' |
| PE | In P.E, the children will be focusing on gymnastics and football. They will be learning how change the shape of their bodies and how to throw and kick in different ways. |
