Our Learning:

English 	In Writing, we will be crafting traditional fairytales, looking at Phillip Pullman's retellings as inspiration. We will also be writing a class Anthology, collating our thoughts and experiences from our time at Abbey Hey.
Maths 	This half term we will be completing a Theme Park Maths unit which will consolidate all of learning as we move towards our end of year reward to a real theme park!
Reading 	We will be consolidating all of our learning from the reading curriculum, looking at a range of texts in preparation for our next adventure to high school.
Science 	Our science focus this half term is Functions of the Human Body, learning about our blood and its components, the respiratory and circulatory systems and investigating the effects of exercise on our heart.
History 	We will be Looking at Power, Empire and Democracy which looks at the impact of the British Empire and how it has shaped modern day Britain.
Art 	In Art, we are looking at Art and Identity, looking at artists whose work critiques the British Empire and explores their own identity in relation to it.
Religion and Worldviews 	During our RE learning, we are learning about a range of philosophers and their beliefs on the soul and life's purpose.
PE 	Our PE Unit is Football. We will be developing competencies in key skills and principles such as defending, attacking, sending, receiving and dribbling a ball.
Music 	In music, we will be honing our singing skills as we learn new and exciting songs as part of our end of year production.
Computing 	In Computing, we will be learning how to be safe gamers, looking at how to stay safe online and use a range of technology to develop our digital competency.
PSHE 	Our unit this half term will be Relationship and Sex Education, looking at changes in our lives, what a safe relationship is and looks like and how to make a baby.
