Our Learning:

English 	In writing, we are going to be crafting narratives, focusing on using dialogue to advance the action and convey character as well as a range of shorter writing opportunities across a range of genres.
Reading 	We will be consolidating all of our learning from the reading curriculum, looking at a range of texts in preparation for our next adventure to high school.
Maths 	This term in maths we are completing maths projects which allow us to practice all the skills we have learnt throughout the maths curriculum.
Science 	Our science focus in Biology this half term is Functions of the Human Body, learning about our blood and its components, the respiratory and circulatory systems and investigating the effects of exercise on our heart.
Geography 	Our focus this term is I am a Geographer where we will be conducting a local field work unit in which we will plan how to use the school's back field to improve our area based on real-life data gathering.
D&T 	In Design and Technology, we will be analysing, designing, creating and evaluating head coverings!
Computing 	In computing, we will be completing our Sensing unit which involves us coding and programming Micro:bits.
Music 	In music, we will be honing our singing skills as we learn new and exciting songs as part of our end-of-year production!
RE 	In RE, we are learning about how Religions and analysing the question: How is an understanding of life's purpose reflected in people's lives?



PSHE 	Our unit this half term will be Relationship and Sex Education, looking at changes in our lives. what a safe relationship is and looks like and how to make a baby.
PE 	Our PE Unit is Football. We will be developing competencies in key skills and principles such as defending, attacking, sending, receiving and dribbling a ball.
