

Rita Ora was born in Pristina, Kosovo (a place in Europe) in 1990. When she was just a baby, her family left Kosovo because it was not safe for them, and they moved to London as refugees. Growing up in London, Rita loved music and went to a special school for performing arts.

She became famous in 2012 with her song "Hot Right Now," which was number one in the UK. Her first album, "Ora," also reached number one. Rita has won awards, acted in movies, and been a judge on TV talent shows. She is proud of her journey and often helps others, especially children and refugees.
