Maths	We will be starting our 'Time' unit where we will tell the time within 5 minutes, as well as looking at

	angles. Finally, we will look at different ways of representing data in our 'Statistics' unit.
Science	Our science topic is 'Magnetism'. We will learn about contact and non-contact forces including friction
