Happy new year to you all! After all the fun of Christmas, we are all eager to see everyone again and continue to work hard. This letter will tell you the information that your child will be learning about in class. Further information about their learning can be found on our school website.

### Getting Ready to Come to School

Children will need to come to school every day:

- Wearing their school uniform
- With their bookbag and water bottle
- Ready to learn!

### Our Learning:

English	 We will be writing traditional tale narratives, using the text 'Usborne 1001 Arabian Nights'. We will then be writing our own dual purpose wildlife adventures using the text 'Atlas of Animal Adventures'.
Reading	 In Reading this term, we will be focusing on all the reading skills, looking in detail at the vocabulary that has been used in a text and why certain vocabulary was chosen.
Maths	 In maths, we will be focusing on measurement, length, perimeter and fractions.
Science	 In Chemistry, we will be learning about particle models. We will be investigating the effect of temperature on the rate of evaporation. We will also be locating solids, liquids and gases in our school environment.
History	 In History, our topic is Early Islamic Civilisation. We will be learning about how knowledge was developed and shared across different civilisations.
Art	 In Art, our topic is the tropical rainforest. Our focus artists are Abel Rodriguez and Henri Rousseau. We will be using water colours, oil pastels and wax resist to create a collage of leaves.
Religion and Worldviews	 In RE we will be learning Christianity, Islam and Humanism. Our focus will be How do people think about poverty, justice & self-sacrifice? The meaning of poverty & relative poverty and the meaning of justice and everyday self-sacrifice.
PE	 In PE this half term, pupils will be developing their gymnastics skills. Pupils will develop balancing, rolling, jumping and inverted movements and use these skills to create more complex sequences.
Music	 In music, we will be continuing to learn to play the trumpet.
Computing	 We will be learning about data and information.
PSHE	 We will be learning how to keep ourselves safe. Questioning, how do I manage risks in my life? What is self-control? What is the difference between legal and illegal drugs? Are all drugs harmful?
