We can't believe we are now half-way through the school year. The children are enjoying Year 2 and making wonderful progress. Let's make this next half term an amazing term for learning. This letter will tell you the information that your child will be learning about in class. Further information about their learning can be found on our school website.

Getting Ready to Come to School

Children will need to come to school every day:

- Wearing their school uniform
- With their bookbag and water bottle
- Ready to learn!

Our Learning:

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| <p>English</p>  | <p>In English, we will be continuing with our unit based on the dragon machine and writing a poem to include expanded noun phrases, verbs and adverbs. After, we will be creating an Information text based on what grown ups do all day. After, we will create a set of instructions based on the story 'how to babysit a grandma.'</p> |
| <p>Maths</p>  | <p>In Maths, the children will be continuing to learn about money and then moving on to our new topic, multiplication and division. This will be followed by a unit about length and height.</p> |
| <p>Science</p>  | <p>In Science, our focus is biology. We will be learning about living things and their habitats. Within this, we will be focusing on micro-habitats and their food chains.</p> |
| <p>History</p>  | <p>In History, we are learning about the Great Fire of London. Sources will be used to tell us what life was like in London in the 1660's. We will be learning about the causes of the fire and the long-term and short-term effects.</p> |
| <p>DT</p>  | <p>In DT we will be designing and making our own vehicle. We will learn about the different parts of the vehicle including the different kinds of axles then using our woodwork skill to create our own prototypes.</p> |
| <p>Religion and Worldviews</p>  | <p>In R.E. we will be learning about Christianity. We will be exploring the question of "why does Easter matter to Christians?" We will focus on the story of Easter week and visit St Clements church for an assembly close to the end of term.</p> |
| <p>PE</p>  | <p>In PE, the focus this half term is athletics. The children will learn to short and long distance run, jump and throw.</p> |
| <p>Music</p>  | <p>In music, we will continue to deepen our understanding of pitch and volume by singing and creating different mouth sounds.</p> |
| <p>Computing</p>  | <p>In Computing, we will focus on creating pictograms based on our science study of living things and their habitats.</p> |
| <p>PSHE</p>  | <p>In PSHE we will be looking at healthy lifestyles and exploring the question "how do I keep myself healthy?" This will include looking at how diet and exercise help to keep us healthy.</p> |
