We are now in the final half term of Year 5! The children have worked incredibly hard and we can't believe how much progress they have made already. Let's make this next half term an amazing term for learning. This letter will tell what your child will be learning about in class. Getting Ready to Come to School

Children will need to come to school every day:

- Wearing their school uniform
- With their bookbag and water bottle
- Ready to learn!

Our Learning:

English 	In Writing, we will be writing a balanced argument based on real life mysteries. Then, we will write a narrative, based on 'The Rabbits' by John Marsden and Shaun Tan.
Reading 	In Reading, we will be focusing on the skills of retrieve, define and infer. We will be exploring a range of texts linked to our writing genres.
Maths 	This half term, we will be learning about angles, decimals, coordinates and translation.
Science 	We will be learning about Earth and space in our physics unit. We will learn about the universe, the planets in our solar system, and why we have day and night.
History 	We will be learning about how knowledge has been shared over time. We will also be comparing different civilisations.
DT 	We will be designing a Smart School using micro-bit to program sensors.
Computing 	In computing, we will be learning about video editing.
Music 	We will listen to and appreciate music, sing collectively, and improvise using instruments.
RE 	This half term, we will explore our personal worldviews through artistic expression.
PSHE 	In PSHE, we will learn about puberty, relationships in our life, and unwanted touch.
PE 	In PE, we will be learning about attacking and defending in football.
