

## Dear Parents,

Our Topic for this half term is Alchemy Island. We will be going on a magical journey to find hidden gold on Alchemy Island. We are going to use our imaginations to help plot our route to this mystery island.

Our learning:

- In Reading, our class texts will be The Shadow Forest by Matt Haig. The key skill that we will be focussing on in Reading is to explore the effect of figurative language found in texts.
- In Writing, we will be producing travel guides for our selected destinations. In addition to this we will be creating potion poetry based on 'Macbeth' by Macbeth.
- In Maths, we are learning how to multiply fractions, and add and subtract decimal numbers.
- In Science, we will be developing our scientific enquiry by observing changes over different periods of time. We will be focussing on what makes our results reliable.
- In Geography, we will be reading six figure grid references. We will use these skills to help us to plan our routes to our magical islands.
- In R.E. we will be exploring Christian values and deciding if we believe that Christians can live by the values of Jesus in the 21st century.
- In P.E. we are applying skills effectively to perform a specific position in sports.
- In PSHE, we will be working on our growth mindset through the programme 'Happy Minds'.
- In Art, we will be painting a portrait which shows emotion in the style of Francis Bacon.
- In Music, we will be improvising and composing music as the soundtrack to our poetry.

Can we please ask that you support your child at home in ensuring they know fluently, their times tables (we recommend using Times Tables Rockstars website).

We expect that they are reading each day independently and to you and they have opportunities to be read to by an adult. Can we ask that you also ensure their home learning projects are completed on time.

You can also use the information on their Knowledge Organisers to test their recall of facts and their understanding of the new vocabulary listed.
