

Live lessons - Code of Conduct

In our remote lessons, we encourage children to have their cameras switched on.

This will:

- support the engagement of pupils in the lesson
- improve behaviour management as the teachers can see when pupils are on task or actively listening
- support phonics with younger pupils, as staff can see and hear pupils making sounds and correct or model as appropriate
- support safeguarding
- support pupils' social and emotional needs by allowing them to see their friends and feel more fully part of a class.

The following code of conduct must be followed during all live lessons:

While your child is online, they must follow the school behaviour expectations as if they were in school

Pupils should wear appropriate clothing during the live lessons

Other members of the household should wear suitable clothing during the live learning

Pupils should be sat in an appropriate location for example, not in bedrooms

Where possible, pupils should be against a neutral background. If this is not possible, please be aware of what is in the background

Language used should be appropriate, including that of any family members

Microphones should be muted unless requested to unmute by the teacher

Taking photos of the screen or recording any online interactions is not permitted

During live sessions, your child should be appropriately supervised and monitored
